In order to qualify for state and federal financial aid, students must be legal permanent residents or citizens. If a student is not yet a legal permanent resident, they should look to private scholarships to help with educational expenses. The scholarships on this list do not require a social security number, legal residency, or citizenship. As a general rule, if an application asks for your social security number and you do not have one yet, leave that space blank but fill out and turn in the application. Lying about your legal status or providing a false social security is a federal offense. Family savings and fundraising can also supplement educational costs.

# Funding Your Education with Private Loans

Finding the money you need to attend college can be a daunting task. For those without citizenship or permanent residency, the obstacles can be great because of ineligibility for federal loans. Thankfully, private lenders may have less stringent eligibility requirements.

# Questions to ask

When contacting a potential lender, here are a few questions you should ask:

- Do you require that borrowers be U.S. Citizens or permanent residents?
- If not, do you require that borrowers have other documentation (i.e., Student Visa, valid SSN, or other INS documents)?
  - Can I be eligible for a loan if I have a co-borrower who is a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident?
    - Does my school participate with your loan program? (this is often necessary)

If you already have a credit card or an account with a particular bank, it wouldn't hurt to start by asking about their loan programs.
