

FINANCIAL GUARANTEE STATEMENT

The United States government requires all international applicants to provide proof of ability to pay educational costs and living expenses before a formal letter of admission and the forms needed for obtaining a student visa can be issued. Therefore, it is critical that you complete this form fully, answering every question, and that you arrange for the required verification letters to be sent promptly. A verification letter is required to match each separate source of funding you list below. These letters must be original (no photocopies) and official. Verification of funds from private (individual) sources must be in the form of a bank letter. Similarly appropriate and official letters of verification must be provided for each government or agency scholarship. You must indicate specific amounts (stated in U.S. dollar equivalents) from each source on this form and the verification letters must do the same. If you will receive financial support from a sponsor living in the U.S., s/he must submit the Form I-134, Affidavit of Support, which is available upon request from the Willamette University Office of Admission.
