ABOUT THE ACADEMIC LISTENER PROGRAM:

- Willamette University's Academic Listener Program allows non-degree-seeking students to attend regularly scheduled undergraduate classes at Willamette University in a non-credit learning environment on a space-available basis. As an Academic Listener, a student may participate to a limited extent in classroom discussion, but will not be required to take any examinations or be required to do any class assignments. Student names will appear on class rosters, and final grades of "Audit" will be given.
