Niels Marquardt, diplomat in residence at Lewis & Clark College, is a former American diplomat who served on five continents under U.S. presidents from Jimmy Carter to Barack Obama. Career highlights include four ambassadorships in Africa and a final posting as Consul General in Sydney. He will share "**One Diplomat's Field experience of the U N across four decades**."

Kyle Lascurettes is Associate Professor of International Affairs at Lewis & Clark College, where he teaches courses in international organizations, global order, and international relations theory. He is the author of *Orders of Exclusion: Great Powers and the Strategic Sources of Foundational Rules in International Relations* (Oxford University Press, 2020), which has won numerous awards in political science and history. He will speak on "The United Nations at 78: assessing its accomplishments against its original aspirations".
