## Willamette University Network Outage:

Willamette's website and services have mostly been restored. It appears that when they restored our files, it was somewhat dated and did not include the March schedule on the ICL Website. And at this point, we are not able to log into the system to publish it. You can still see the March schedule from the <u>Schedule</u> <u>Reports</u>. Note the tabs at the bottom to show the information in different formats.

**Change password:** If you have a Willamette network account with an email address ending with "@willamette.edu", you need to change your password asap if you haven't already since the cyber attack.

Please follow the instructions in the <u>password reset guide</u> located on our <u>Outage Information site</u>. To access the site, you will need to use your current Willamette login and password credentials.

While it is preferred that you reset your password while you are connected to a computer that is hardwired on any of our campuses or using a computer or cell phone that is connected to the WUTemp wireless network, you should be able to reset your password remotely.

## Willamette University Film Screening: "Carving the Divine: Buddhist Sculptors of Japan" Thursday, March 14, 2024 at 7:00 PM. in Ford Hall Rm 122.

The Department of Art History presents a screening of the award-winning documentary, "Carving the Divine: Buddhist Sculptors of Japan," followed by a Q&A session with director Yujiro Seki.

Carving the Divine explores the ancient tradition of the carving of Buddhist icons as it follows the arduous training of apprentices by a master carver, and illuminates the tradition of passing down the forms, traditions, and techniques of this exacting craft to a new generation of carvers.
