Advantages of having a Willamette Network Account:

- 1. Receive daily "**Today@Willamette**" emails a one-stop shop for Willamette community members to share information about the university's people, programs and events.
- 2. Receive "**Words from Waller**", a regular letter (emails) to the Willamette Community from University President, Dr. Steve Thorsett, with campus updates and announcements.

- 3. **Willamette email account:** Willamette emails are actually Gmail accounts. Email addresses will be your username followed by "@willamette.edu".
- 4. Google Document apps, tools, etc. and file storage (free): G Suite for Education: Explore other Google-provided tools, such as Google Sheets (spreadsheets), Docs (word processor), Slides (like PowerPoint), Calendar, Photos, Drive, and Sites, etc. Free! Netfiles: Network storage for your important files. <u>More Information</u>
- 5. Office 365: Use Office365 web-apps or install Microsoft Office applications (Word, Excel, Power Point, etc.) on your computers and mobile devices. Willamette University participates in a program called Microsoft Student Advantage, which allows the university to provide access to Microsoft Office to students, staff and faculty at no cost for their personal devices. Students, faculty and staff can choose to download the full Microsoft Office ProPlus suite for any non-university-owned computer device (limitations apply). More Information below
- 6. **Print services** while on campus (print to printers in various buildings, including Kaneko lobby and Hatfield Library)
- 7. **Zoom**: Willamette University provides faculty, staff, and students with free Zoom accounts that can be used for participation in and recording of audio and video conferencing using just about any computer or smart mobile device via WISE or directly from the Zoom app.
- 8. Internet Access (Wifi) this step must be done while on campus.

Creating a New Network Account (Email address):

If you don't already have a WU account, you can create one now. You must have a Willamette ID number, and be a current member of the ICL program as designated by the ICL Board of Directors. The Registrar's office maintains a copy of this list. Your *Willamette ID number* can be found on your Compass Card (student ID card).

Office 365 at Willamette University

Willamette University participates in a program called Microsoft Student Advantage, which allows the university to provide access to Microsoft Office to students, staff and faculty at no cost for their personal devices. Students, faculty and staff can choose to download the full Microsoft Office ProPlus suite for any non-university-owned computer device (limitations apply).

ICL members are permitted to download and install Office 365 for free. You will need your Willamette user name and password to log in to the Office 365 portal. If you haven't set up a WU account yet, go <u>here</u> first.

The Office suite includes the following programs: Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Access, Publisher, Outlook, OneDrive for Business. There is no ability to install or uninstall these programs individually.

Versions of Office are available for PC, Mac, iOS, and Android.
